





Announcement: Third Arab Land Conference

18, 19 and 20 February 2025 Rabat, Morocco

The Kingdom of Morocco and the Arab Land Initiative are delighted to announce the Third Arab Land Conference. The conference will accommodate both in-person and virtual participation and is scheduled to take place between the 18th and the 20th of February 2025 in Rabat, Morocco.

The event is organized by the Moroccan Ministry of National Territory and Urban Planning, Housing and City Policy, UN-Habitat and the Global Land Tool Network (GLTN), in collaboration with UNESCWA, the League of Arab States, the World Bank and other international partners, and with the support of the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development of Germany (BMZ).

The upcoming 3rd edition, set to take place in Morocco, follows the success of the 1st edition held in Dubai, UAE, in 2018, and the 2nd edition in Cairo, Egypt, in 2021. The Conference represents a significant step toward achieving the Sustainable Development Goals and effective land governance in the Arab region. It aims to enhance land management and administration by addressing the key land-related topics, serving as a platform for discussing country experiences, presenting new research, garnering high-level support and commitment to land governance, and empowering and developing the capacities of land stakeholders across the region.

The conference registration will be opened by the end of September. Experts, practitioners and partners will have the opportunity to present papers and organize side events and special sessions. The submission process for papers and events will be announced on the Arab Land Initiative website (https://arablandinitiative.gltn.net/) by the end of September as well.
