It is our great pleasure to invite you for a Technical pre-workshop “Fit-for-Purpose Land Administration in the Arab Region” in the week of the 3rd Arab Land Conference. It will be organised on Monday 17 February at the **School of Geomatic Sciences and Land Survey Engineering at the Institut Agronomique et Vétérinaire Hassan II** in Rabat, Morocco. It will take place from 9.00-17.00, including lunch, coffee and tea breaks. Organisers are besides the **Institut Agronomique et Vétérinaire Hassan II**, Kadaster International, ITC, and FIG.

The objective of the workshop is to support Land Administration professionals and scholars in the Arab Region to increase their awareness, capacity, and advocacy on FELA, FFPLA, and Women’s access to land tools and approaches in local country contexts. The training will be conducted by experts from KI, ITC, and FIG through demonstrations, interactive deliberations, presentations, group work and exercises.

The workshop will also contribute to the ‘training of trainers’ efforts already undertaken by CRTEAN, ISTIDAMA and NELGA in the region.

The workshop is a product of the School for Land Administration Studies (SLAS) which is a cooperation between the International institute for Geo-Information Science and Earth Observation ('ITC') and the Cadastre, Land Registry and Mapping Agency ('Kadaster'), the Netherlands. The School aims to contribute to the development of institutions and individuals in the field of land management and land administration for both strategic and operational level.

The workshop will be carried on under the leadership of Rohan Bennett, Associate Professor at ITC and senior advisor at Kadaster International. There will be simultaneous Arab-English translation available during the event.
