Distribution of land ownership

The area that has already been settled by the LWSC, amounting to more than
 1.43 million dunums does not give information about the gender distribution of land ownership because the Table of Rights form does not include gender disaggregation.

 To support in gathering data on the gender distribution of land ownership in Palestine, UN-Habitat supported with the disaggregation of the Table of Rights for over 1.158 million dunums which were settled by LWSC. State Of Palestine Land & Water settlement commission






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Gender distribution of land ownership

Around 1.158 million dunums; 80 per cent were disaggregated out of the 1.43 million dunums that is already settled by LWSC




Gender distribution of land ownership



The women share in the land ownership *fluctuates according to the governorate*, the *highest* percentage of the women land ownership was recorded in *Jericho and Tubas* and the *lowest* was recorded in *Jenin*.

Gender distribution of land ownership


As for lands registered for *private ownership for individuals* only (without inheritors), the total number of dunums of these lands is approximately **746,000 dunums**:

Disaggregated by sex


The average value of dunums of land registered to men exceeds the average value of dunums registered to women, standing at approximately JOD 38,161 and JOD 36,076, respectively.




• There are *geographical discrepancies at the governorate level*; for instance, the average value of dunums registered to women is higher than those registered to men (but not by a significant amount).




△ □ □ Geopolitical classification









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







Value of agricultural land











With regards to male/female ownership of land and how it intersects with poverty rates, it was noticed both male and female ownership of lands significantly decreased with higher poverty rates, but the intensity of this was greater for females than for males.






Separation Barrier

47,000 dunums are lands owned behind the separation barrier; of which, 36,877 dunums (or 78.5 per cent) are owned by men, and 10,123 dunums (or 21.5 per cent) are owned by women.







...the agricultural productivity and the overall food production increases.












Why women need HLP rights?

...their participation in decision-making, within their families and communities, and in the overall political debate increases.

...they are more likely to have the financial security they need, the household welfare increases and children have better chances to be educated.












WHY WOMEN'S HLP RIGHTS MATTER

Further, in displacement and crises-affected contexts, when women have housing, land and property rights...

- ...they are better protected from violence, extreme weather conditions and other health hazards.
- ...they are better able to **provide for themselves and their dependent** and to cope with the lack of family support.
- ...they are better able to manage the negative economic and social impact of conflict.
- ...their **engagement in peace processes** and the likelihood of peace agreements to be implemented increase.




LAND, WOMEN EMPOWERMENT AND SOCIOECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE ARAB REGION: EVIDENCE-BASED PERSPECTIVES

Developed in partnership with the <u>Union of Agricultural Work</u> <u>Committees</u> (UAWC) from Palestine

The study examines the **factors affecting women's land tenure security** in the Arab region and their connection to women's **empowerment and socioeconomic development.**

It evidences the reality of **gender- and land-related patterns on the ground and provides actionable recommendations** for decision-makers, stakeholders and activists.

WHY WOMEN'S HLP RIGHTS MATTER

Securing land tenure for women and men is essential to realise human and socioeconomic development. According to a regional study carried out by UN-Habitat, GLTN and UAWC (2023), there is a **positive correlation between land tenure security and improved living conditions**:

WHY WOMEN'S HLP RIGHTS MATTER

- > 56% of men and 49% of women report that tenure rights helped them access education
- > 52% of men and 42% of women report that tenure rights helped them secure better healthcare
- ➤ Women's land and property rights contribute to their leadership and participation in decision-making. Securing women's land and property rights...
 - ... strenghtens women's leadership and participation in decision-making by rebalancing roles both within families and communities.
 - ... increases their civic engagement and public participation.
 - ... defines and enhances their **social security, status and identity**, all necessary elements to boost their participation in local decision-making processes and **political power**.

WHAT PROTECTS WOMEN'S HOUSING, LAND AND PROPERTY RIGHTS?

INTERNATIONAL LEGAL FRAMEWORKS/ DECLARATIONS

- At the international level, women's land and property rights are protected since the 1940s with a number of legal instruments under two streams of legislation: one protecting the rights to adequate housing and protection from eviction, and one recognizing the equal rights of men and women.
- The main **international declarations** protecting women's equal rights to land and property include:
 - Universal Declaration of Human Rights (1948)
 - Declaration on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women (1967)
 - Voluntary Guidelines on the Responsible Governance of Tenure of Lands, Fisheries and Forest in the Context of National Food Security (2012)
 - 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (2015)
 - New Urban Agenda (2016)
 - Pinheiro Principles on Housing and Property Restitution for Refugees and Displaced Persons (2005)

INTERNATIONAL LEGAL FRAMEWORKS / COVENTIONS

- International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR): Ratified in 1975.
- International Covenant on Economic, Social, and Cultural Rights (ICESCR): Ratified in 1975.
- Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW): Ratified in 1992 with reservations on Article 9(2) (nationality of children) and Article 16 (equality in marriage and family relations).
- International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination (ICERD): Ratified in 1974.


ISLAMIC LAW

- It is important to note that, according to Islamic law:
 - Women possess independent legal, economic and spiritual identity with respect to access to land and property.
 - Women have the right to acquire, hold, use, administer and dispose of property including land.
 - Women can hold land titles individually and jointly.
 - There are no jurisprudential impediments that prevent joint marital property from being integrated in the marital contract.
 - Marriage is a spiritual, social and legal contract between two independent legal entities who have equal rights to negotiate terms, including property regimes and access to land, through the marital contract.
 - Women retain control over pre-marital property and finances throughout marriage and, when applicable, after divorce and in case of widowhood.

Overview on Gender equality in the Arab Region

GENDER EQUALITY IN THE ARAB REGION

The Arab region has the **highest gender gap globally** (about 40%) yet to be closed, with Yemen, Iraq and Saudi Arabia among the least performant countries

Note: Figure shows change in the average WBL index score across seven regions between 1970 and 2020. OECD = Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development.


MAIN CHALLENGES LIMITING WOMEN'S LAND RIGHTS TO HLP

The land tenure security challenges faced by women are complex and context specific, most common challenges include:

- Weak land governance and rule of law
- Discriminatory social and religious norms and practices
- Lack of knowledge and awareness about land rights
- > Limited/lack of enforcement of women's land rights
- > Lack of HLP documents under women's name
- > Unequal participation to institutions and land administration processes
- ➤ **Ignorance and misinterpretation** of statutory and religious laws protecting women HLP and inheritance rights.
- > **Discrimination** due to their civil status, age, class, wealth, sexual orientation etc.

MAIN CHALLENGES LIMITING WOMEN'S RIGHTS TO HLP

- > Unequal power dynamics between women and men (at all levels)
- Lack of knowledge and awareness about women land rights (most women are unaware of their right to joint property in marriage, or of keeping the premarital property under their name, thus losing their land and property to their husbands when they marry and especially in case of divorce).
- ➤ Limited access to economic assets and resources including finance opportunities
- ➤ **Practical barriers** to accessing land administration systems, including to dispute resolution mechanisms (travel, cost, childcare, etc.)

In case of divorce or death of the husband, a woman risks to lose her land and housing, because the couple's property is usually solely registered in the name of the husband, even if the wife has financially contributed to its purchase.

Fewer women purchase land compared to men.

- > Women in Arab societies have **limited access to resources** or control over income that grants them purchasing power.
- > Poverty rates are disproportionate across gender: a greater number of women are living in poverty or deep poverty.
- > Women's **employment rates are lower** than men's, and they have limited access to finance and credit opportunities.

HOW TO PROTECT WOMEN'S HOUSING, LAND AND PROPERTY RIGHTS?

RECOMMENDATIONS

AWARENESS AND ADVOCACY

- Increase awareness on the importance of gender equality and land tenure security
- Simplify, translate and popularize laws, administrative regulations and legal documents
- Enhance the understanding of key stakeholders about land-related national, regional and international legal frameworks, religious and customary laws

RESEARCH, KNOWLEDGE AND DATA

- Continue undertaking field assessments on gender and land issues, monitor progress
- Disaggregate data by sex, age and by socio-economic indicators
- Analise the nexus between tenure insecurity and the various phases of conflict and monitor the housing,
 land and property rights violations
- Promote the role of civil society organizations as mediators between institutions and communities

WOMEN'S PARTICIPATION

- Promote knowledge-sharing among entry-level female entrepreneurs seeking to use their land for income generation
- Capacitate women's associations to deal with housing, land and property rights and other land-related issues
- Promote and increase women's employment in the different land-related professions

RECOMMENDATIONS

GENDER-RESPONSIVE REFORMS

- Reform and align national policies and regulations with international human rights frameworks and amend the discriminatory laws
- In countries with legal pluralism, harmonize the provisions on women's rights to land
- Reform land registration and administration systems to be more gender responsive
- Remove practical barriers limiting women's access to land administration services
- Provide practical support for women at the grassroots

INHERITANCE AND MARITAL PROPERTY

- Regulate and combat inheritance renunciation practices
- Encourage a holistic approach to estate planning to complement inheritance, particularly for Muslim women, such as the use of wills, gifts or donations, dower, etc.
- Promote the use of written marital contracts and promote joint property arrangements.
- Develop the capacity of religious registrars and other key actors involved in the process of contracting marriage and raise the awareness of women and men to transform the marital contract in a tool to access and secure women's land and property rights.
- Provide access to non-confrontational land disputes resolution mechanisms for women and provide legal support, shelter and protection for women and children under threat of violence when claiming their rights.

How to increase women's participation in land-related processes?

To increase women's empowerment and participation in decision making...


Raise women's awareness and understanding of housing, land and property rights, so that they are better able to claim them and engage in land and HLP-related processes.











How to increase women's participation in land-related processes?

To increase women's empowerment and participation in decision making...

Promote, strengthen and develop the capacities of women and women's associations to participate in land-related processes such as management of land and land-related resources, land dispute resolution, land policy reform processes, etc.












How to increase women's participation in land-related processes?

To increase women's empowerment and participation in decision making...

Guarantee women's participation in peace negotiations, land conflicts resolution mechanisms, and land-related commissions to ensure women's grievances and needs are addressed during the negotiations.











How to increase women's participation in land-related processes?

To increase women's empowerment and participation in decision making...

Collect and analyse sex-disaggregated data on land administration processes, land use patterns, issues faced by women in accessing land and other land-related dynamics to guide reforms and decision making.




