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






### HUMAN-INDUCED DEGRADATION AND AGRIFOOD SYSTEMS

- 1 660 million hectares of human-degraded land
- Over 60 percent of this degradation occurs on agricultural land affecting food production from cropland and pastures
- Restoring degraded agricultural land is vital for sustainable and more productive agrifood systems



#### LAND TENURE: FACTS AND FIGURES

- Less than half population have legally recognized land tenure documentation
- 1% of farms control >70% of agricultural land. 84% of farms are <2 hectares in size and use 12% of the agricultural land



 Between 40-50% of the world's land are occupied by Indigenous Peoples or Local Communities

- Men have greater ownership or more secure tenure rights over agricultural land than do women
- 50% of countries for which data is available have weak legal protections for women's land rights






 1 billion people perceive they are at risk of being evicted

Pathway 3: Securing women's tenure rights and access to land and natural resources

Pathway 4: Setting up accessible and transparent grievance and dispute resolution mechanisms





## FRAMING THE VGGT INTO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UNCCD (2)

Pathway 5: Designing and implementing tenureresponsive and participatory integrated land use planning



Pathway 6: Supporting LDN through land administration tools



Pathway 7: Recognizing and documenting legitimate tenure rights on public lands



Pathway 8: Recognizing and documenting tenure rights for the sustainable management of commons



Pathway 9: Allocating and strengthening rights and duties on private land



### **LESSONS LEARNT**

- Conveners in the driver's seat
- Mapping of stakeholders' projects/ programmes/initiatives
- Efforts to ensure a sufficient level of information on tenure, land degradation neutrality and gender
- Flexibility to organize national consultations
- Zooming on agro-ecological zones with sub-national contributions
- Designing group work to allow processing the information and some first recommendations to emerge
- Synergies with project/programme/ initiatives that can support further use of the recommendations



### MAIN RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strengthen coordination and dialogue between land and tenure sectors
- Awareness raising and develop capacities over linkages between tenure insecurity and Land Degradation
- Priority to tenure security and land restoration in land use planning processes
- Integration of the findings from national consultations into Land Degradation Neutrality Target Setting and Action plans
- Improvement of policy and legal frameworks
- Collective forms of access to land are worth exploring to restore land
