



FIG Mentoring Program

The FIG Young Surveyors Network (YSN) and the FIG African Regional Network (ARN) started piloting a mentoring program for young surveyors in the African Region, with strategic and conceptual support and IP from the Geospatial Council of Australia's Mentoring Program.


